- Repository of restricted contents, such as private deliverables or internal work documents


At the same time, web 2.0 profiles (Twitter, Facebook and LinkedIn) has been linked to the website

2 Private Project Website

Project Consortium has selected a content management system (CMS) to host the website. The CMS is Drupal, an open source tool.

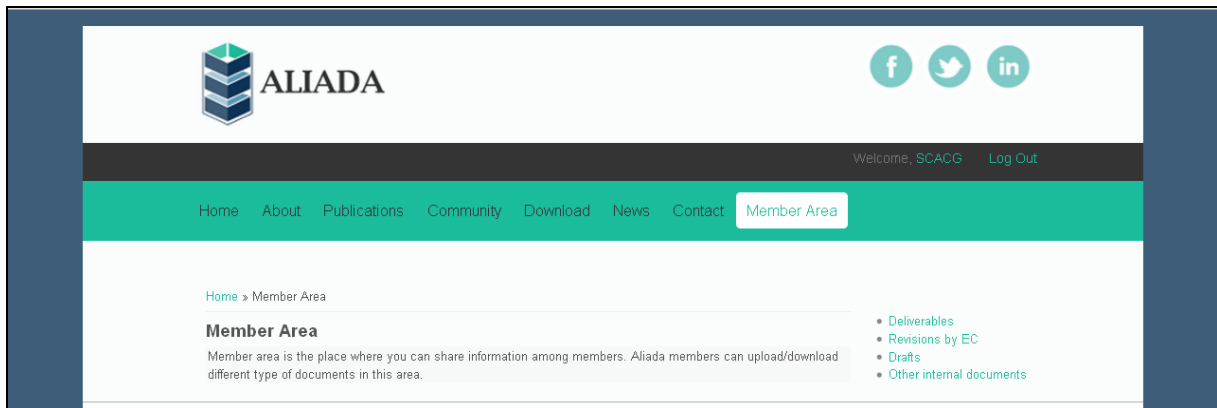
The private part of the website consists of an access to the website's restricted content. Consortium members and EC will be able to access to that restricted content using a user account previously assigned by the manager of the website.

The access to the private repository is from the Member Area of the website:



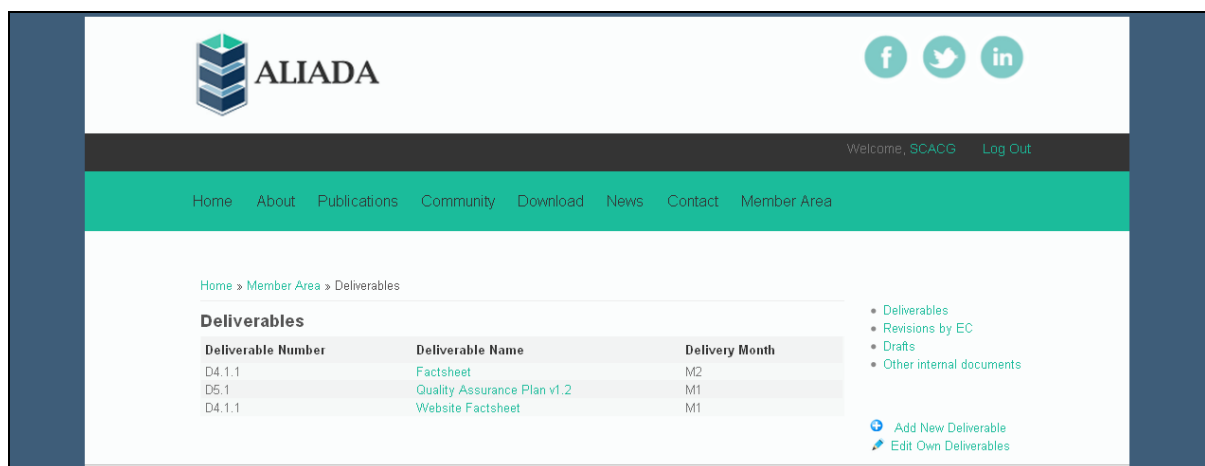
Member Area - Login

- **Deliverables:** public and private deliverables that have been sent to the EC. Every authorized users can download or view all of them and add new ones, but only their own deliverables can be edited.



Member Area - Deliverables

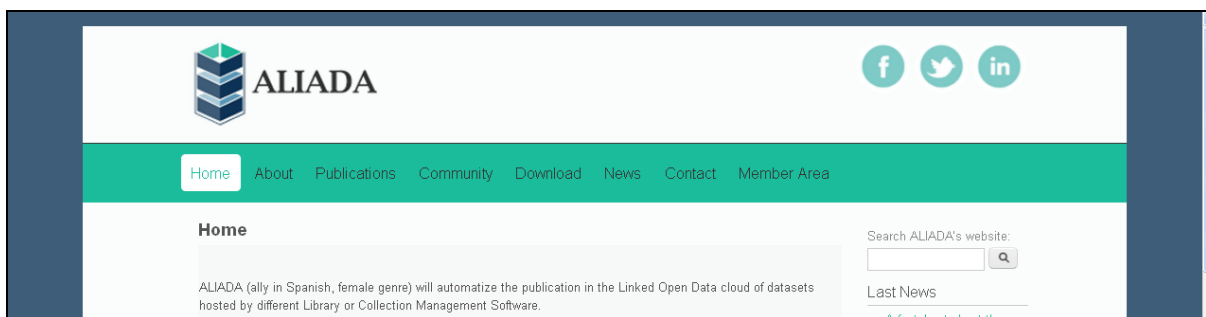
- **Revisions by the EC:** Project Officer can upload document reviews or other documents to the Consortium's private repository. All the authorized users can view or download those uploaded documents, but only EC user can manage them.
- **Drafts:** Non-official documents can be exchanged among the Consortium members using this feature.
- **Other internal documents:** finally, other type of documents generated during the project can also be uploaded to the private repository to have them available in the cloud.

3 Web 2.0 Profiles

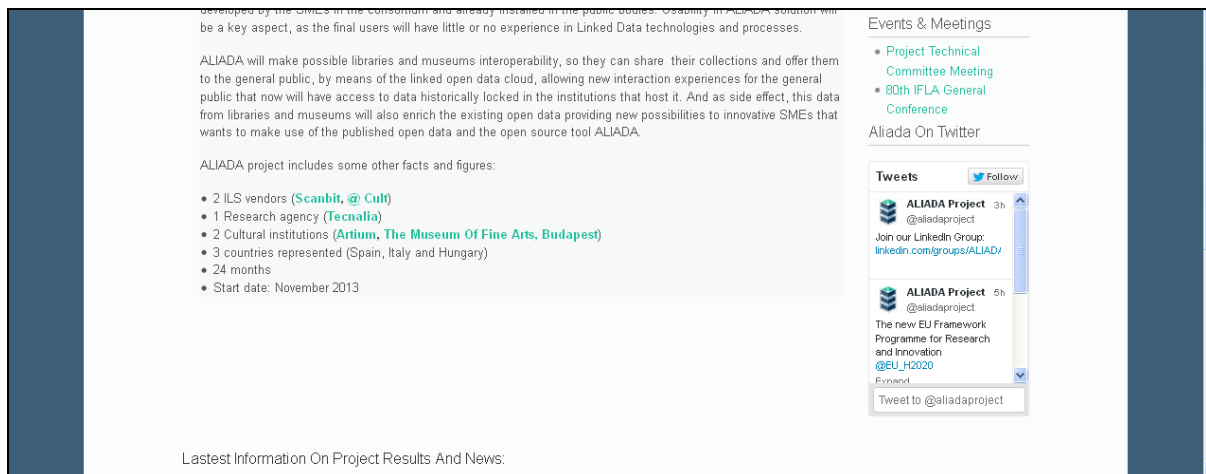

- as links (Twitter, Facebook, LinkedIn)

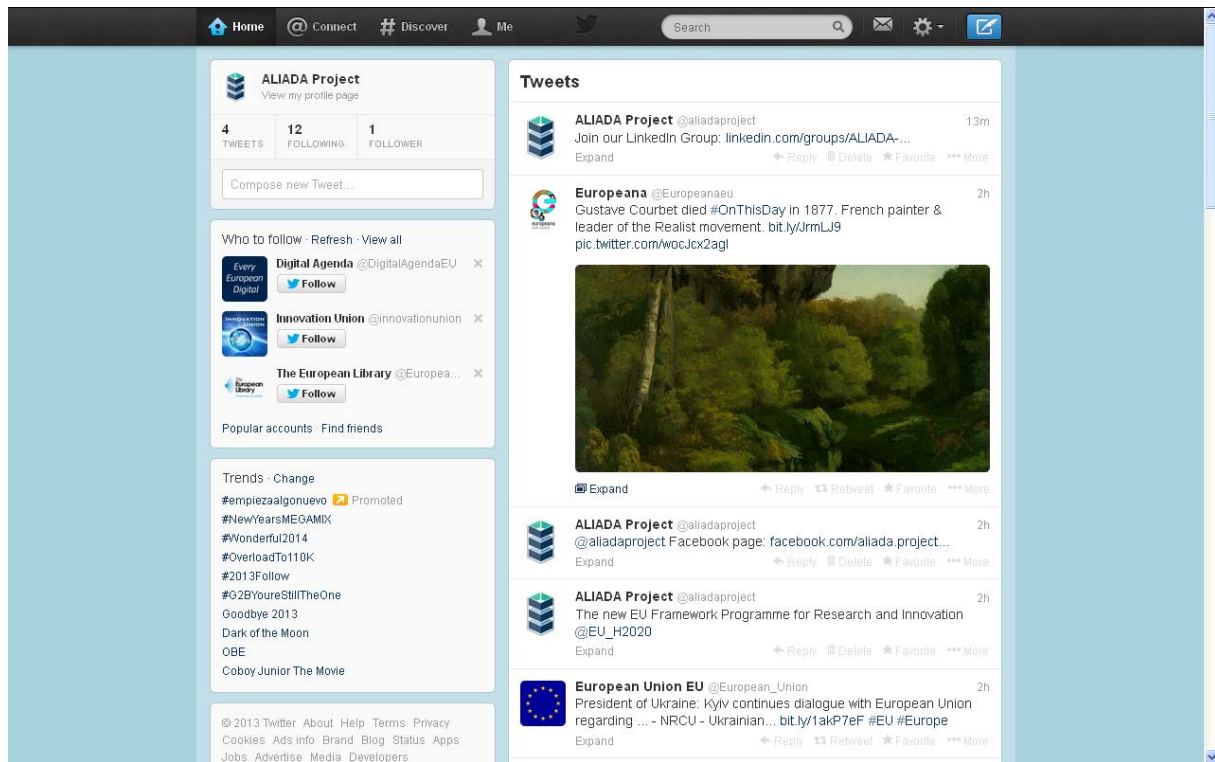


